



User Guide - Classic Lockers

The following guide shows the steps for using your locker for the first time.

GETTING STARTED

1. Remove packaging

- The keys for the locker doors are taped inside the locker.
- 2 Door, 4 door and 2 step lockers have the option of a latch lock or camlock, and a 1 door locker a flush lock. Camlock and flush locks are lockable, and come with 2 keys per lock. Latchlocks secure the door ready for you to fit a padlock. (Max 6.3mm shank).
- If applicable, retrieve the keys, insert into the lock and turn clockwise to lock. Each key is numbered to match the code printed on the corresponding lock.
- The locker door should move freely - open, close and lock if applicable.

2. Prepare for use

- Remove tape inside the lockers that has been used to secure accessories for transit (like the mirror). If features like coat rail, coat hook or an extra shelf have been ordered these will already be fitted.

3. Loading and unloading

- Never use shelves as a ladder to climb.
- Never overload the shelves. Shelves are limited to uniformly distributed loads of 10kgs each.
- As lockers are over 1200mm high we recommend that seismic restraints are fitted. Please contact Precision on 0800 800 059 or service@precisionworkspace.co.nz for further details.



4. MOVING LOCKERS

- If relocating the lockers all contents should be taken out first.
- Lockers should always be lifted (2 people) or moved with a hand trolley, never drag lockers across the floor.
- Lockers that have been joined into banks can be moved together in banks of no more than 3. Larger banks will need to be disconnected.
- Lockers are commonly joined into banks with a set of small bolt and nut or may be riveted together. We recommend you contact Precision on 800 800 059 if in any doubt.
- Note - if moving lockers to a new location on a raised plinth, the plinth size must be sufficient to support the locker fully with no more than a 10mm overhang all around.
