

The following guide shows the steps for using your cabinet for the first time.

GETTING STARTED

- 1. Remove packaging
- The keys for the tambour door and the drawers are taped inside the top
- Retrieve the keys, insert into locks and turn clockwise to lock the caddy door and drawers. Each key is numbered to match the code printed on the corresponding lock.
- The cabinet door and drawers should move freely open, close and lock.
- 2. Prepare for use
- Remove tape that has been used to secure the pencil tray inside the top drawer, and the shelf in the tambour for transit.
- Check the clips supporting the tambour shelf are firmly in place and have not dislodged during transit.
- 3. Loading and unloading
- Never sit on or climb onto the top of the caddy.
- Never overload the drawers. Drawers have a load capacity of 20kg load carrying capacity per drawer.
- Never overload the shelves. Shelves are limited to uniformly distributed loads of 20kgs
- 4. Moving caddys
- The caddy comes with castors making relocating the unit easy. When not being relocated it is recommended the lock on the castors be engaged to prevent unforeseen movement.
